Introducing our speakers

Brendan Callaghan SJ is a Jesuit, catholic priest, and psychologist. Alongside 30 years of teaching psychology of religion at Heythrop College, University of London, he has run workshops around issues of sexuality and spirituality for various Christian groups ranging from both dioceses of Portsmouth to those preparing to work as spiritual directors and retreat givers. He is currently Master of Campion Hall Oxford.

Revd Carla Grosch Miller serves in the United Reformed Church as minister of St Columba's, Oxford and Cumnor URCs. She is a former civil rights attorney (Alaska) and was ordained in the United Church of Christ (US). She lectures in the theology of sexuality, sexual ethics and sex in ministry, and is doing doctoral work on the link between sexuality and spirituality.
